Dear parishioners:

The Holy Father has asked us to pray with him to our Lady every day in May for the end of the pandemic at 12 noon Denver time. It will be broadcast somehow???

The Archbishop announced that the obligation to attend mass on Sunday resumes Pentecost Sunday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Many of you are already in the habit of attending mass again. Remember it is for our spiritual nourishment that we all are called to the Lord's table. This is not a zoom meeting!

The Easter appeal to our parishioners and other donors was launched three weeks ago. It is a mail campaign attempting to raise \$50,000 for windows in the office and rectory, landscaping at the church, the painting & sealing of the stained-glass window and a tool shed behind St. Joseph Hall. Please send your contribution back in the enclosed envelope. Thanks to those who already donated about \$40,000 to the appeal.

Make sure we have your email and cell phone number. Our quick communication with you is by flocknote. If you do not receive them, we do not have your cell phone or email.

We will continue to follow safe procedures, allowing families to sit together but social distancing them from others. We are now at 50% capacity. We will go to a larger number on Pentecost to accommodate everyone. If you are one or 2 people, please take a small pew! Large families in big pews and cry rooms. Public masses are at 8 a.m. M - F. Adoration till 10:30.

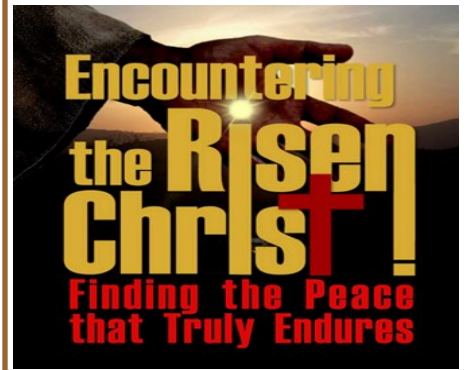

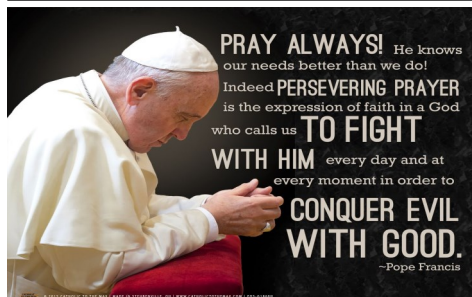

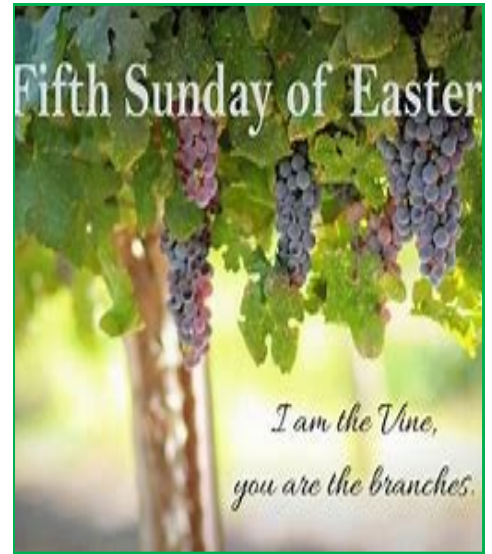
