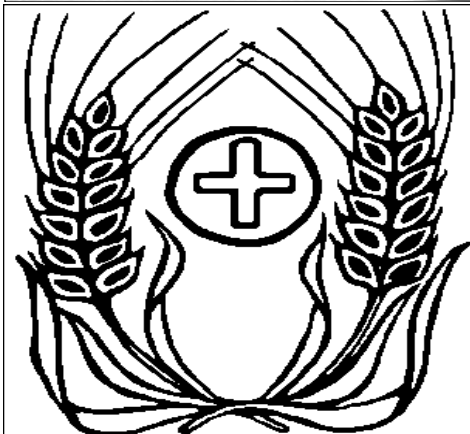
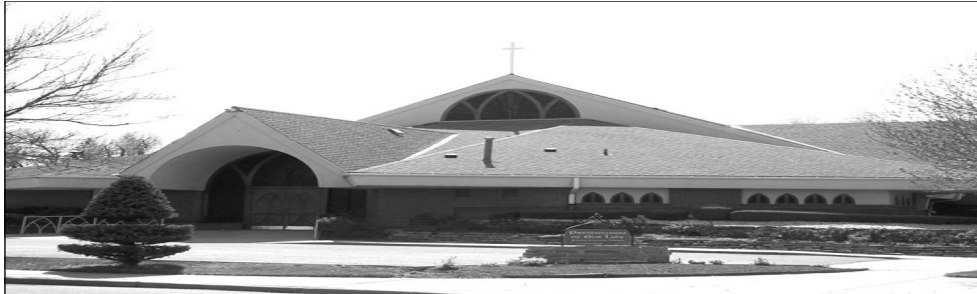

Take your missalette home each week and bring it back to sing! If you want one for next year let me know. Correction: Cost will be \$10. I ordered 60.

Church life is gradually improving! But we are running out of the Clorox wipes. We cannot get any more for now. We will have to use paper towels and the spray sanitizer after each mass. Ushers will spray the towels for you. We are still at 84 spaces. We are exceeding this capacity at the 12 noon Spanish Mass. If you come after the church is filled, you will not be admitted. Please attend one of the other masses or watch our livestream @presentationdenver.org. Public masses are at 8 a.m. M - F.

Thank you Fr. Guillermo, Jaime Torres, Eileen Figaro, Bob Krier and Raphael Saldana for the Confirmation liturgies.

Please support the ACA Campaign. Archbishop gave Presentation \$13,500 from the campaign and the assistance of Catholic Community Services to help us raise our offertory to pre-Covid levels. Religious Education [News](#): Registration is over until Sept. for the Confirmation class. New students: first come first served. Classes will be limited to 10 students this year. When we run out of classrooms & teachers enrollment will be closed.

Families asking for infant baptism must make sure that godparents (padrinos) are married in the church and are confirmed. Parents must be registered in the parish. Call Deacon Pablo for preparation class held the second Monday in English at 7 and Spanish at 8.

Marriage preparation: Please see us 8 months before your marriage. Classes: \$185 per couple. Register at www.catholicmarriageprep.com. For classes see our parish website: "presentationdenver.org". There are many helpful articles on it as well.

Register your King Soopers card. Go to Kingsoopers.com and enter code: NU379 with your card number. We get 5% of your purchases.

FR. ED

This weekend we are registering all students for religious education after all masses and will continue until August 9, or until we reach the maximum number of students we can accept. We will have no more than 10 students per class and all must wear face masks. The fee is the same \$75 and you have the option of home schooling your child if you desire. Classes will begin on the weekend of October 3, Saturday in Spanish and Sunday in English. You must be over the age of 8 to register and we require a baptism certificate at time of registration or a birth certificate if not baptized. Please contact Deacon Pablo Salas at the parish office if you have any questions.

Debes ser mayor de 8 años para registrar y requerimos un certificado de bautismo al momento del registro o un certificado de nacimiento si no está bautizado. 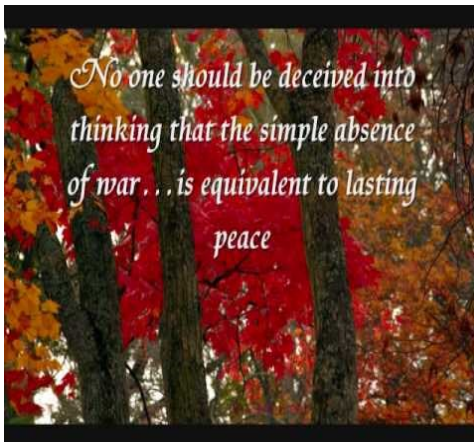
